Please note that if you are giving from a bank account, it is better to choose "Bank Account"

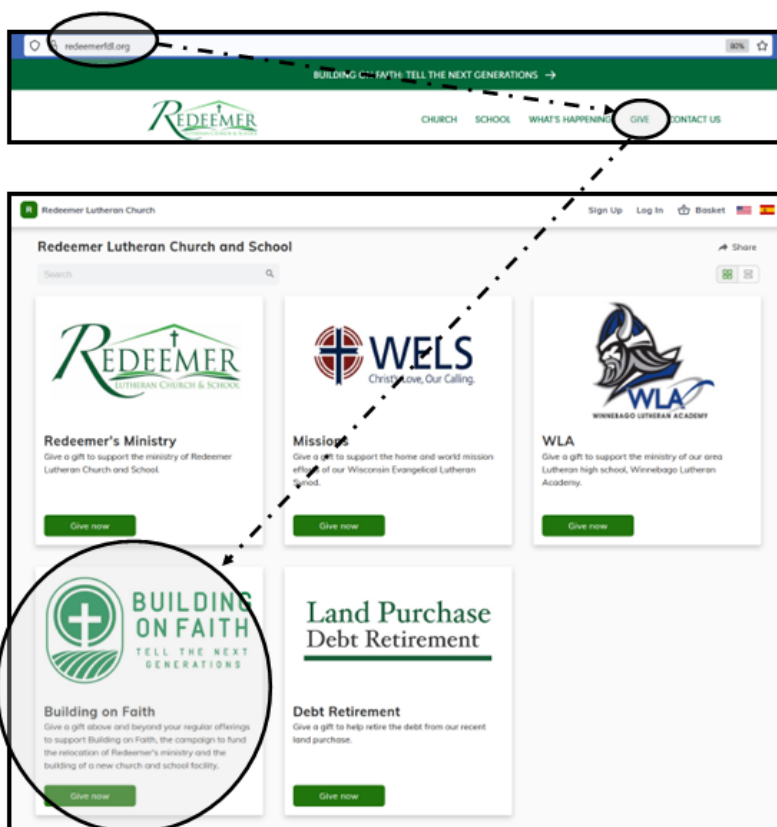
than "Debit Card", as 2.5% is deducted from the gift as a vendor fee for cards.

Many have already started giving to the *Building on Faith* campaign, with \$16,029 already given last Sunday! \$63,508 has been given since the beginning of 2025.



COMMITMENTS TO DATE – Out of roughly 200 active adult families/ individuals, 115 commitments have been made. In addition, 4 youth members and 2 non-members have also made commitments for 121 total. God be praised!

The commitments as of May 26 total \$1,394,738, or 93% of our goal!
