

RELOCATION UPDATE

The Town of Fond du Lac Board approved the rezoning of our new property to medium residential and approved the special exemption to build a church and school.

Our lender, Bank First, met with us last week, and is putting together the paperwork for the bond we would use for our loan. Though there is a higher cost up front, the savings over ten years would be over \$500,000 in interest payments. The current rates are 4.75-4.85%

Excel finished our construction drawings on March 6th. Catalyst Construction, our construction manager, has sent the projects elements out for bid. We'll meet with Catalyst in late March or early April to go over the bids.

Groundbreaking Sunday is May 17th. More details will be coming.
